



JONAH - DON'T YOU CARE?


- God steps in The Call

GOD STEPS IN — THE CALL

- Why did Jonah decide to go 2000 miles in the opposite direction?
- Jonah 4:2 it spells it out, "This is why I ran away to Tarshish. I knew that you are a merciful and compassionate God, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love. You are eager to turn back from destroying people".





GOD STEPS IN - THE CALL

- Jonah did not carry God's heart for salvation.
- Israel was called to be a model of how to live righteously and be recipients of God's love.
- God said "Go outside and show them how to live"





GOD STEPS IN — THE CALL

- Jonah was no ordinary man. He was a prophet.
- He did what prophets did but only within his own nation
- Was Jonah a man after God's own heart?
- Do I truly carry God's heart for this lost world?





GOD STEPS IN — THE STORM


- You can't keep running away from God (Psalm 139)
- A storm rages, chaos and fear all around, human effort to save themselves
- Wake up Don't you care?





GOD STEPS IN — THE STORM

- Are we asleep to the turmoil, pain, fear, confusion of people's lives around us?
- Are we on a boat going the wrong way?
- God is saying: "Wake up, don't you care?"





GOD STEPS IN — THE STORM

- God wants us to recapture his heart for mission
- God wants us to find a fresh passion for his Kingdom
- Set a fire down in my soul that I can't contain and I can't control...





GOD STEPS IN — THE TURNING

- Jonah was never going to turn around without a miracle; the power of God
- We need a fresh impartation of the power of the Holy Spirit
- Without God we cannot; without us God will not – Saint Augustine
- Jonah surrendered his life; we too need to surrender





GOD STEPS IN - THE TURNING

- Surrendering to God didn't take Jonah to Tarshish
- Neither did it take him to Nineveh
- It took him back to the call
- You don't have to be fixed to serve God's purposes, but you do have to be willing.
- What has God been calling us to do?
