>passion

- 1. a strong and barely controllable emotion. "a man of impetuous passion"
 - >a state or outburst of strong emotion.

Similar: rage, blind rage, fit of rage/anger/temper, temper, towering rage, outburst of anger, tantrum, fury, frenzy



intense sexual love. "their all-consuming passion for each other"

Iove, desire, sexual love, sexual desire, lust, ardour, hunger, yearning, longing, craving, adoration



>an intense desire or enthusiasm for something. "the English have a passion for gardens"

Fervour, intensity, enthusiasm, eagerness, zeal, vigour, feeling, emotion, fire, heat, fierceness, excitement, energy, animation, gusto, zest, spirit, commitment, fanaticism, violence, fervency, love, obsession, fixation, compulsion, addiction



- 2. the suffering and death of Jesus. "meditations on the Passion of Christ"
 - >an account of the Passion from any of the Gospels.
 - Similar: crucifixion, pain, suffering, agony, martyrdom



≻apathy

1. lack of interest, enthusiasm, or concern. "widespread apathy among students"

Similar: indifference, uninterest, lack of enthusiasm, unconcern, unresponsiveness, passivity, passiveness, detachment, lack of involvement, coolness, listlessness, lethargy, boredom





If anyone has material possessions and sees his brother in need but has no pity on him, how can the love of God be in him?


