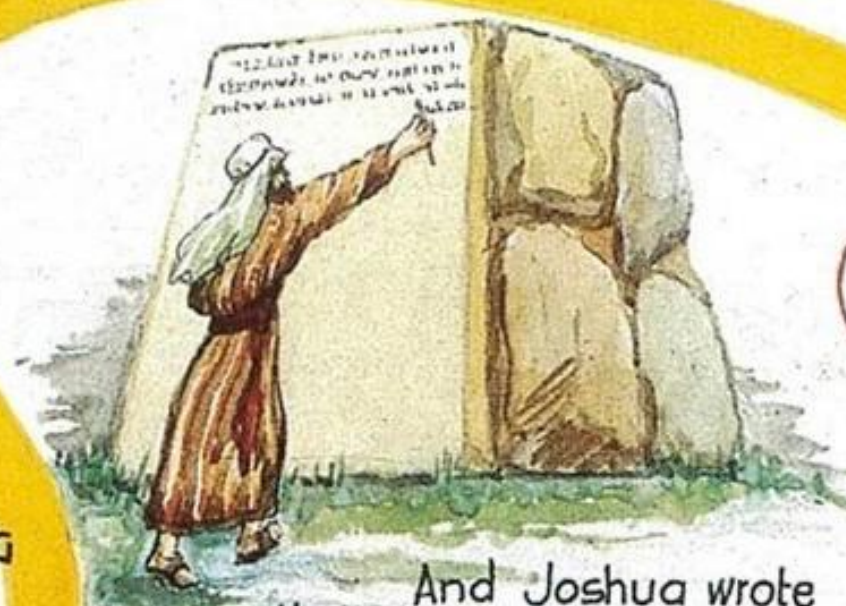

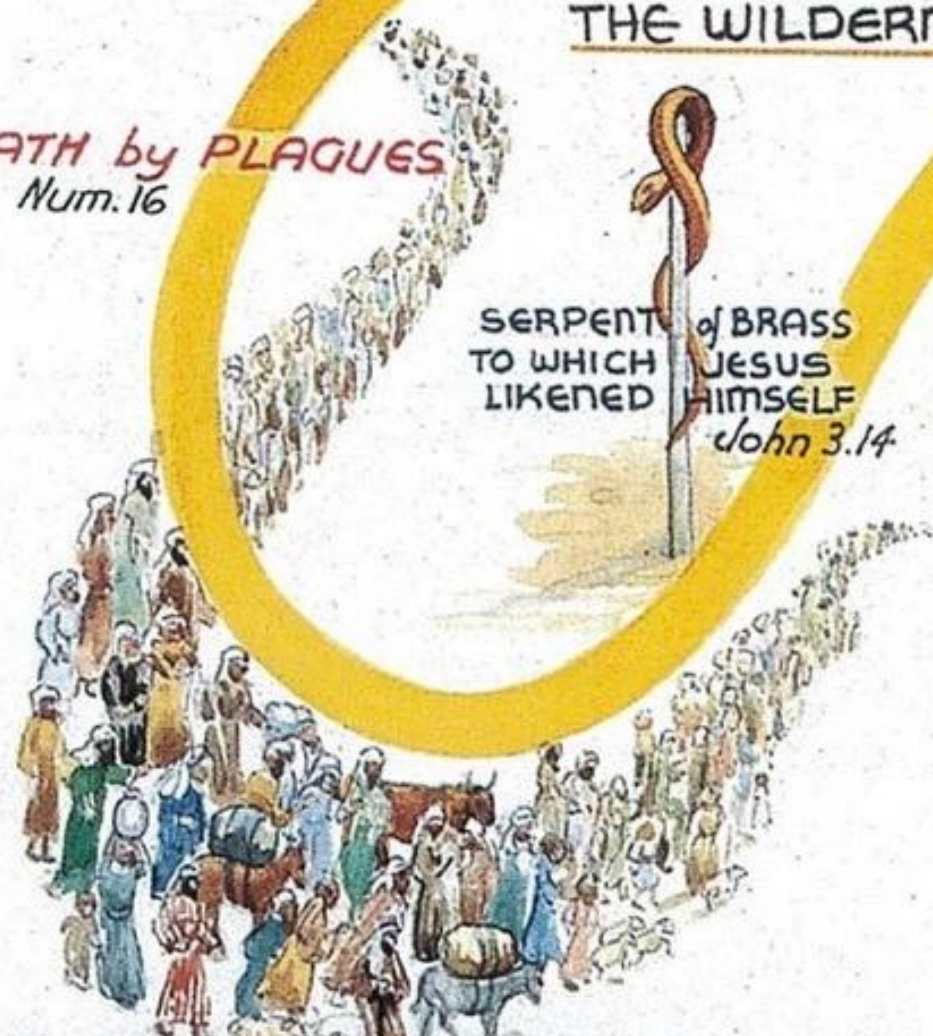

ISRAELITES JOURNEY ON TO KADESH BARNEA



“At the end of forty days they returned from spying out the land. And they came to Moses and Aaron and to all the congregation of the people of Israel in the wilderness of Paran, at Kadesh. They brought back word to them and to all the congregation, and showed them the fruit of the land. And they told him, **“We came to the land to which you sent us. It flows with milk and honey, and this is its fruit. However, the people who dwell in the land are strong, and the cities are fortified and very large.** And besides, we saw the descendants of Anak there. The Amalekites dwell in the land of the Negeb.
